BREAST PUMPS

AULTMAN & MERCY DELIVERIES:

- A. If you have Buckeye or Caresource, the lactation consultants at the hospital have breast pump prescriptions. The lactation consultants will arrange for a pump for you and you will go home from the hospital with the pump.
- B. If you have Aultcare, you will need to call them and ask if you have coverage for a breast pump. If you do, the lactation consultants at the hospital will arrange for a pump for you and you will go home from hospital with the pump.
- C. If you have any other insurance, you will need to call your insurance company ahead of time.
 - 1. You need to find out the following:
 - a. Do they cover a breast pump? If so, what kind of pump (manual, double electric, hospital grade rental pump) and from what manufacturer?
 - b. What medical supply company (DME) are you to use?
- D. If your insurance company covers breast pump, you can order pump online at Edgepark, Aeroflow or Mommyxpress. They will verify your insurance and then send our office the request for the breast pump. If you have Medicaid, Caresource or Buckeye insurance, they will only pay for breast pump every 5 years.

*****Breast pumps will not be ordered, referred or prescribed until 3rd trimester; unless unforeseen circumstances approved by a provider.**
